

OC&E Whistle Signals

— —	Release brakes. Proceed.
o o o	When standing back.
— — o —	Approaching public crossing at grade. To be prolonged or repeated until crossing is occupied by engine or cars.
— o	Approaching tunnels, curves or other locations where view may be obstructed.
Succession of short sounds	Alarm for persons or livestock on track.

OC&E Bell Signals

The engine bell must be rung –

- When the engine is about to move.
- When approaching and passing public crossings at grade.
- When running through tunnels.
- When passing a train standing on an adjacent track.
- When passing passenger stations.

The unnecessary use of bell or whistle is prohibited.
